

OCD VOLLEYBALL SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

THIS ORGANIZATION IS COMMITTED TO PROVIDING ATHLETES AND SPECTATORS WITH A SAFE ENVIRONMENT AND A POSITIVE EXPERIENCE. ENTRY TO THIS PRIVATELY SANCTIONED EVENT IS GRANTED AS A COURTESY. IF YOU ATTEND THIS, OR ANY OCD VOLLEYBALL EVENT, YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING CODE OF CONDUCT GUIDELINES:

SPECTATORS ARE EXPECTED TO:

1. Abide by the official rules and policies of OCD Volleyball
2. Display good sportsmanship at all times.
3. Encourage event participants, regardless of the outcome on the court.
4. Honor the rules of the host and the host facility.
5. Generate goodwill by being polite and respectful to those around me at this event.
6. Redirect any negative comments from others to the respective Event Director.
7. Direct all concerns regarding officiating to the Event Director as opposed to the work team.
8. Immediately notify the Event Director in the event that I witness any illegal activity.
9. Acknowledge effort and good performance, remembering that all of the players in this event are amateur athletes.
10. Model exemplary spectator behavior while attending this event.

SPECTATORS MUST NOT:

1. Harass, intimidate or otherwise insult work teams, players, spectators, facility staff or OCD Volleyball Staff.
2. Verbally, physically or sexually assault work teams, players, spectators, facility staff or OCD Volleyball Staff.
2. Coach against other teams from the sidelines.
3. Bring and/or carry any firearms or any other illegal weapons to any OCD Volleyball event.
4. Bring, purchase, or consume alcohol at any OCD Volleyball Event where it is expressly forbidden
5. Bring, purchase, or consume any illegal substances at any OCD Volleyball Event

Note: Any violation of this Code of Conduct will result in the spectator being asked to leave the site immediately, and may result in the spectator possibly being banned from attending future OCD Volleyball events. The Event Director has the final say regarding their individual event. Local law enforcement will be contacted if necessary to resolve any disputes or altercations.
